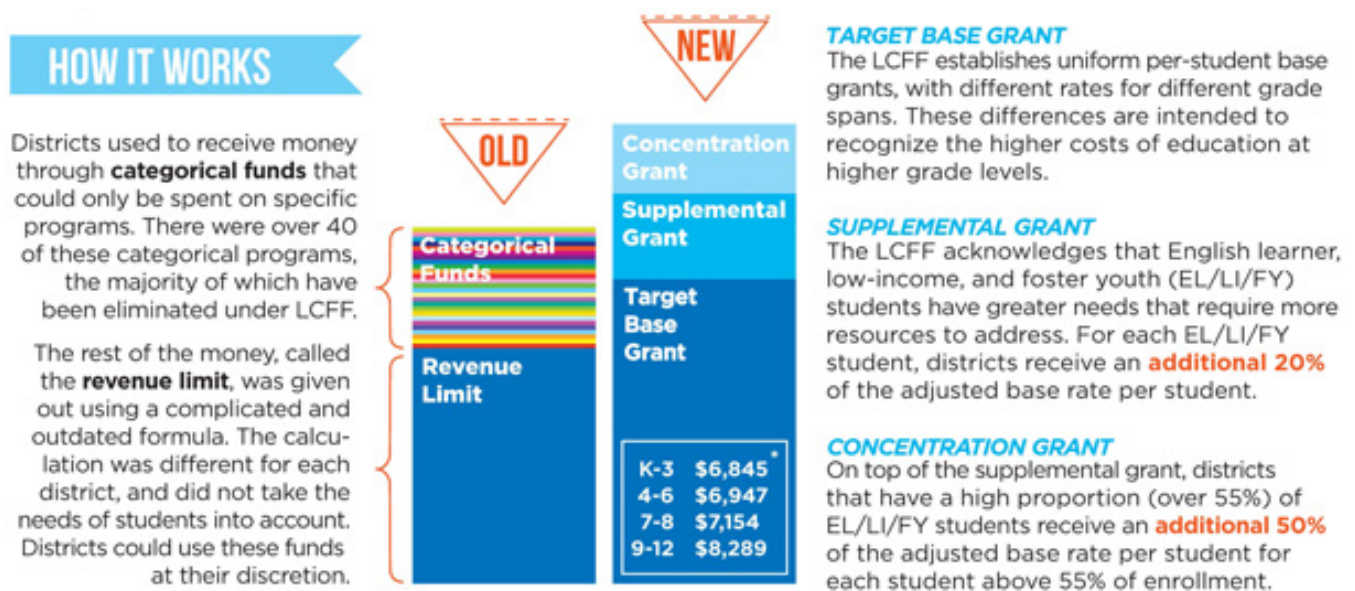


# LCAP Overview...

## Ensuring our students' receive the best educational experience we can provide at ENHS.

In 2013, the state restructured its formula for determining how much money school districts receive. This new funding formula, known as the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), also determines the amount of money school districts receive from the State. LCFF also:

- ✚ Shifts spending decisions from the State to the District.
- ✚ Provides extra funding for students with greater challenges.
- ✚ Gives the District more flexibility for how to spend its money to improve our schools.



In order to hold districts accountable to their budget and improvement goals, each district must draft and adopt a Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP). East Nicolaus High School's LCAP needs to demonstrate how our budget will be utilized in order to achieve our goals. To help each district identify its goals, the state has created eight specific areas to ensure all students within the district succeed.
